

Fonterra Elections 2024

9 August 2024

Nominations for the Fonterra Board of Directors' Election open today, with an election to be held for two Farmer-elected Directors.

This year, Leonie Guiney, Peter McBride and John Nicholls retire by rotation. Both Peter and John have confirmed that they will be standing for re-election while Leonie is retiring from the Board.

Candidates may nominate themselves in one of two ways:

- The **Independent Assessment Process** which runs first, with a nomination period starting today and ending at midday on 23 August 2024; or
- The Non-Assessment Process, with a nomination period from 23 September to midday on 3 October 2024.

Prospective candidates can choose to go through either of these processes but not both in the same year.

Independent Assessment Panel

The Independently Assessed Candidates will be assessed by an Independent Assessment Panel of three highly respected governance experts. This year, the Panel members are Dame Joan Withers (Chair), Patrick Strange and Mark Verbiest. You can find out more about the Panel in the Independent Assessment Panel Search Brief.
